

CALL FOR PAPERS

The VII Postgraduate Conference: Management, Hospitality & Tourism, organised by the School of Management, Hospitality & Tourism, University of the Algarve, will take place on 15 July 2016. It offers young researchers an informal space for multi-disciplinary discussion and critical reflection in the areas of management, hospitality and tourism. It is open to postgraduate students as well as to researchers who have recently obtained their PhD.

Topic areas

Tourism, Hospitality, Marketing, Management, ICT

Presentations and posters are accepted.

Presentations will be limited to 20 minutes, plus 10 minutes for discussion. Papers will be organised in thematic panels, with a moderator and an expert discussant.

Posters (A1 size, 594mm x 841mm) will be exhibited in a specially designated area. Authors of posters will be allotted a time during which they can present and discuss their poster. Printing, transportation and presentation of accepted posters is the sole responsibility of the respective authors.

Authors will also be invited to submit their papers to the academic journals *Dos Algarves: A Multidisciplinary e-Journal* (www.dosalgarves.com) and *Tourism & Management Studies* (http://tmstudies.net).

The conference will have two keynote plenary sessions:

Morning plenary session: Zélia Breda (Professor and Researcher at the University of Aveiro). Topic: Research in Tourism.

Afternoon plenary session: Roundtable on Research Pathways, with:

Margarida Santos (Professor, ESGHT and co-editor of the Tourism & Management Studies Journal): 'How to write an academic paper';



Cláudia Almeida (Professor, ESGHT): 'Doing a Postdoc and international networking';

Fernando Perna (Professor, ESGHT): 'Research Projects and partners'.

- Abstracts will be reviewed by at least two anonymous referees. All abstracts selected will be made available on the conference website and in the Book of Abstracts (with ISSN).
